Eligibility and Selection Criteria

To be considered for the Paschal Carter Scholarship, the Denison Application and Paschal Carter Scholarship Application must be completed and received by email or postmarked no later than **January 15, 2012**. The applicant must have been named a National Merit Semi-finalist by the National Merit Scholarship Corporation. Candidates should present evidence of outstanding academic achievement and potential for significant contributions to the Denison classroom and intellectual life of the college.

The Paschal Carter Scholarship is valued at \$40,000. In addition, Paschal Carter Scholars receive a \$3,000 fellowship which can be used for research, internships and travel abroad while enrolled at Denison. In addition, any finalist who designates Denison with the National Merit Corporation will receive a supplemental \$2,000 renewable stipend to be used toward billable charges.

January 15	Deadline to submit the Common Application and the Paschal Carter Scholarship application.
January 31	Interview deadline. If a student has previously interviewed either on-campus or off-campus that interview will count for the scholarship requirement.
February	National Merit Finalist status verified.
March	Paschal Carter Scholars announced.
