

I. Guidelines for Student Organization Applications

Please note: there is no application form as such. Your proposal responding to the questions below constitutes your application. Funds for entrepreneurial student organization activities are allocated annually. Once funds are depleted for the academic year, applications will only be considered for the following fiscal year.

Proposals should include:

1. Cover sheet with
 1. Student Organization Name and List of Members
 2. Student Organization Contact or Leader
 3. Denison ID Number
 4. Slayter box number
 5. Student Organization Advisor Name
2. Clear description of the project or program
3. A description of how this project is consistent with the Burton D. Morgan Program for Liberal Arts and Entrepreneurship Education [objective](#).
4. Work plan, methodology, and schedule of entrepreneurial activity.
5. Budget including projected expenses and income from entrepreneurial activity.
6. Letter of evaluation from student organization advisor assessing the project and work plan. This letter may be submitted separately, and electronically sent to Stephanie Hunt-Theophilus at hunts@denison.edu.

II. Criteria for Proposal Evaluation

Merit of the Project

1. Is the proposed work consistent with the Burton D. Morgan Program for Liberal Arts and Entrepreneurship [objective](#)?

Conception, Definition and Organization of the Project

1. Does the proposal establish a clearly defined set of objectives for the project, and do the planned activities described in the proposal lead to the logical completion of the objectives?
2. Is there evidence that the student organization is sufficiently immersed in the issue to undertake the innovation related activity?
3. Are the objectives of the project congruent with the purpose of the student organization?

Importance of the Project

1. How original is this proposed project?
2. Is there a demonstrated need for the proposed social and/or commercial venture?

Appropriateness of the Scope of the Project in the Proposed Time Frame

1. Does the proposal demonstrate a realistic timeline for completion of entrepreneurial activity?

III. Selection Process

Student organizations will be selected on a competitive basis by faculty and student advisory committee members of the Burton D. Morgan Liberal Arts and Entrepreneurship Education Program.

The Burton D. Morgan Program for Liberal Arts and Entrepreneurship Education must be listed as a co-sponsor on all program advertising.
