Social entrepreneurship is a rapidly expanding field that represents efforts to develop and implement innovative ways to address social problems. In this workshop students will be introduced to the theory, methods, and practice of this developing field through case studies, experiences in the community, and conversations with social entrepreneurs. Participants will gain an understanding of the skills necessary and the opportunities that exist to engage in this important work. Some of the topics to be addressed are: creating a vision, developing a strategy, and addressing funding issues.

The workshop will consist of classroom presentations, discussions, and field trips. Participants are encouraged to identify an area of interest that they can use as a focus for their work during the workshop and beyond. The workshop will begin with dinner and an introductory session Sunday evening, August 23 and end Friday afternoon, August 28. This workshop is a full-time commitment for the week –participants will not have time for other activities or work.

Dr. Marci McCaulay will be directing the workshop. Students will be provided housing on Denison's campus for the week for a nominal fee of approximately \$60. This fee may be waived for Pell grant recipients or others that demonstrate need. Materials for the workshop and most meals will also be provided. The workshop is open to 35 current Denison students.
