Captains: It is up to captains to enforce all rules. [Game rules](#) are posted on the web. Failure to comply with the below will result in immediate ejections from the game and may result in ejection from the league

- Poor Sportsmanship and bad mouthing the officials will not be tolerated
- IN-SEASON VARSITY ATHLETES (current fall sports) ARE NOT ELIGIBLE to participate in intramurals: football, field hockey, volleyball, men's and women's soccer, men's and women's cross country, men's and women's swimming.
- **Ten Run Rule** is in effect after 5 innings.

OFFICIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Players

- a) In-season varsity athletes (fall sports) are not eligible to participate in intramurals. These sports include: Men's and Women's Soccer, Men's and Women's Swimming and Diving, Men's and Women's Cross Country, Football, Field Hockey, and Volleyball.
- b) Each team shall consist of a maximum of ten and a minimum of eight players, 4 of which must be outfielders. No player shall wear dangerous equipment including casts or hard material such as a watch.
- c) Unsportsmanlike conduct or rough play will not be tolerated, resulting in the dismissal from a game at the discretion of the umpires and may result in suspension from intramural activities. Any inappropriate language and/or gestures toward the umpires of the match will result in immediate dismissal from the game. The Intramural Coordinator will attend all matches and all disputes should be registered with him or her. All disputes will then be directed to the Intramural Council for review.

The Game

- a) The winner of a coin toss shall win possession of the ball at the beginning of the match.
- b) The game shall last seven innings unless the team at bat in the bottom half of the seventh inning is ahead in score.
- c) Each team must arrive at the scheduled time. If a team is over ten minutes late, they will forfeit the match. After two forfeits during the season, the team must forfeit the remainder of the season.

Rule 3: Playing Regulations

- a) A run shall be cancelled if a third out occurs on the play due to a force out or if the scoring runner has committed a batting order or base running infraction on the play and the appeal is successful.
- b) The game shall be slow-pitch, with pitches thrown underhand from the pitching mound. The trajectory arc of the pitched ball shall be between six and twelve feet before reaching home plate.
- c) The pitcher shall not delay the game by repeatedly failing to throw legitimately. This includes acts mentioned in 3-1 and pitches which do not enter or pass near the strike zone.
- d) A player who bats out of order shall be declared out. This infraction shall not be considered unless there is an appeal by either team prior to the first pitch delivered to the next batters.
- e) The batter shall be declared out for: accumulating three strikes, batting the ball while obviously being outside the batters box, bunting or chopping down on the ball, throwing the bat at an opponent or in a way that interferes with play, bating out of order, batting a fly ball which is intentionally dropped by a defensive player in or near the infield, provided there are less than two outs and a runner is on first base, and batting an out under the infield fly restrictions.
- f) The batter shall be declared out if they bat a fly ball under the following circumstances: there must be less than two outs, first and second base must be occupied by runners, the ball must be easily caught by an infielder, or the ball must be batted in fair territory.
- g) A strike occurs when one swings at and misses a pitched ball, bats a foul tip, or bats a foul ball (not a third strike).
- h) Runners may advance only during a live ball or due to an awarded base. While the ball is dead, runners must remain on base until the ball is batted or comes alive. Umpires shall call time when the ball becomes dead.
- i) No defensive player shall obstruct a runner; not including fielding or playing a ball, penalty is an awarded base.
- j) A runner shall not interfere with a defensive player attempting to throw or play the ball, nor intentionally slide into a defensive player while base running. A runner shall not be penalized for incidental contact while sliding into a base. The penalty is an out awarded at the fault of the player in question.
- k) A runner who leaves base before the ball is batted, fails to tag up on a fly out, or fails to touch a proper base while base running may be put out by the opposing team on subsequent appeal. An umpire shall be notified and the runner must be tagged with the ball or the base in question must be touched by a defensive player holding the ball as in a force out. The appeal must be made during the dead ball period prior to the first pitch to the next batter.
- l) A runner who intentionally touches the ball during play or is hit by a batted ball while off base is out. Ball becomes dead immediately following the occurrence.
- m) If the ball is overthrown in play and goes out of play, each runner shall advance one base.
