Official Golf Rules and Regulations

IM Code of Conduct

- a) Understand, appreciate and abide by the rules of the game.
- b) Respect the integrity and judgement of game officials and the intramural staff.
- c) Be responsible for your actions and maintain self-control.
- d) Do not taunt or bait opponents and refrain from using foul or abusive language.

Note that any Intramural participant or team not following the Intramural Code of Conduct is grounds for dismissal from a game or the league.

Rule 1: The Players

- a) In-season varsity athletes (fall sports and spring sports, depending on the season) are not eligible to participate in intramurals. These sports include: Men's and Women's Soccer, Men's and Women's Swimming and Diving, Men's and Women's Cross Country, Men's and Women's Track and Field, Men's and Women's Lacrosse, Football, Field Hockey, and Volleyball.
- b) Appropriate clothing for the course is required at all times. If you have questions, call the Granville Golf Course.
- c) Unsportsmanlike conduct or inappropriate behavior on the course will not be tolerated, resulting in the dismissal from the contest at the discretion of the IM Coordinator and may result in suspension from intramural activities. Any inappropriate language and/or gestures toward anyone on the course or any participant in the program will result in immediate dismissal from the league. The Intramural Coordinator will attend all matches and all disputes should be registered with him or her. All disputes will then be directed to the Intramural Council for review.

Rule 2: The Procedures

- a) All golfers should report to the Granville Golf Course at least ten to fifteen minutes before your tee time to be assured a tee time and spot to play.
- b) All participants will pay the \$17.00 greens fee up front at time of play and will be reimbursed \$5 per round played. The use of a golf cart is not a reimbursable expense.
- c) In order to be reimbursed by the Intramural Department, participants must submit all receipts to the Intramural Coordinator in person at time of contest or in his or her Slayter Box immediately following the contest. The participants name must be printed on the top of the receipt.
- d) All scorecards must be returned to the Intramural Coordinator for referencing and tabulation.
- e) Participants must provide their own clubs and appropriate attire for the course as well as transportation to the Club.
- f) If the weather is questionable, contact either the Intramural Coordinator or the Granville Golf Course.

Rule 3: The Denison Intramural Cup

- a) The Ryder Cup format will be used to play the Intramural Cup competition and participants will play eighteen holes each day. The tournament fee is \$60.00 with a reimbursement of \$20 for thirty-six holes, with receipt. If you have questions regarding rules or the format itself, please address those to the Intramural Coordinator.
