GENERAL LEAGUE INFORMATION

The intramural student coordinators in charge of the Indoor Open Soccer League are Mike Hourigan (317-420-9019), John Lanctot (847-977-0019), and Phil Madden (513-470-1503).

Open competition means that teams may be comprised of all men, all women or co-ed. There are 2 divisions competing in the league and the top 3 teams will advance to the playoffs. The format will be a round robin tournament and games will be played in Livingston Gym.

It is up to co-captains to enforce all rules. Game rules are posted [on-line](#), are published in this document, and hard copies will be available at the games. Failure to comply with the below will result in immediate ejections from the game and may result in ejection from the league.

- All players will be required to sign a waiver to participate and it is the co-captains' responsibility to make sure their team members have signed the waiver before they play. Waivers may be obtained from the event coordinator at the gym. **IT WILL BE UP TO THE CO-CAPTAINS TO MAKE SURE YOUR TEAM MEMBERS SIGN!**

- **We expect co-captains to set the tone of respect and sportsmanship for their teams.** Poor Sportsmanship, vulgarity or threatening remarks by team members or your fans directed at someone or other teams will not be tolerated and will be grounds for expulsion from the event or league.

- IN-SEASON VARSITY ATHLETES (current winter sports) ARE NOT ELIGIBLE to participate in intramurals: baseball, softball, track and field, lacrosse, tennis and golf.

OFFICIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Players

- a) In-season varsity athletes (both winter and spring sports) are not eligible to participate in intramurals. These sports include: Men's and Women's Lacrosse, Men's and Women's Tennis, Men's and Women's Outdoor Track and Field, Baseball, Softball, and Golf.
- b) Each team shall consist of five players and one goalkeeper. No player shall wear dangerous equipment including casts or hard material such as a watch.
- c) Unsportsmanlike conduct or rough play will not be tolerated, resulting in the dismissal from a game at the discretion of the referee and may result in suspension from intramural activities. Any inappropriate language and/or gestures toward the referee of the match will result in immediate dismissal from the game. The Intramural Coordinator will attend all matches and all disputes should be registered with him or her. All disputes will then be directed to the Intramural Council for review.

The Game

- a) Each game is scheduled for three eight-minute periods, with two minutes between periods. There is not overtime.
- b) Each team must arrive at the scheduled time. If a team is over ten minutes late, they will forfeit the match. After two forfeits during the season, the team must forfeit the remainder of the season.
- c) The clock starts when the puck is put into play and touched by a member of either team. Play is continuous. When play is stopped it should be resumed within fifteen seconds. The official will call running (or delayed) fouls by raising the hand and indicating to the scorer, the number of the player who commits the foul. The only time the officials blow the whistle is for a goal or a foul resulting in a penalty. In this case, there are no substitutions during the penalty.
- d) Other than during a foul penalty, there is free substitution at any time.
- e) When the puck crosses the goal line, side or front, one point is scored. The puck can deflect off the player or equipment to count as a goal, but cannot be kicked into the goal.

Playing Regulations

- a) The goalkeeper may use hands to clear the puck away from the goal but may not hold the puck for more than five seconds, or throw the puck towards the other end of the playing area. Penalty for throwing the puck is a loss of possession and a running foul. The other team will then start play again at the center circle.
- b) The goalkeeper may be pulled from the goal box but is restricted to the center line. No other player may enter the goal box without being charged with a foul.
- c) The keeper may drop to the ground to stop a shot, but may not remain lying on the ground unless injured. All other players are not permitted to go down on the floor to stop the shot on goal due to the fact that they are not wearing pads and facemasks; they can only go down on their knees. This infraction will result in a two minute penalty.
- d) Running Fouls (penalty called and a change of possession) include: Swinging the stick above waist height, throwing the puck by the goalkeeper, a player other than the goalkeeper entering the goal box, and chopping the puck to raise it in the air (exception for shots on goal)
- e) High Sticking Fouls (two minute penalty) include: Any hit above the waist of a player, or any contact to the head - resulting in immediate ejection from the game
- f) Roughing Fouls (one minute penalty) include: Hacking or striking with a stick (slashing), pushing (cross checking), blocking with the body (interference), tripping or any other action considered dangerous to other players, and the holding an opponent
- g) Misconduct Fouls (one minute penalty) include: Delay of game (any player deliberately stopping the puck) and too many players on the floor
