

IM Code of Conduct

- a) Understand, appreciate and abide by the rules of the game.
- b) Respect the integrity and judgement of game officials and the intramural staff.
- c) Be responsible for your actions and maintain self-control.
- d) Do not taunt or bait opponents and refrain from using foul or abusive language.

Note that any Intramural participant or team not following the Intramural Code of Conduct is grounds for dismissal from a game or the league.

Rule 1: The Players

- a) In-season In-season varsity and junior varsity athletes are not eligible to play. Athletes from the corresponding sports are not eligible to play. **Athletes not eligible to play include:** baseball, golf, lacrosse, softball, tennis, and track and field. If you are a fall athlete participating in a spring non-traditional sport that is not a corresponding sport, please check with your coach about playing intramurals.
- b) Unsportsmanlike conduct or rough play will not be tolerated, resulting in the dismissal from a game at the discretion of the Intramural Coordinator and may result in suspension from intramural activities. Any inappropriate language and/or gestures toward the opposing team will result in immediate dismissal from the game. The Intramural Coordinator will attend all matches and all disputes should be registered with him or her. All disputes will then be directed to the Intramural Council for review.

Rule 2: The Game

- a) Each match consists of an eight game pro-set. The first player to win eight games by two wins the match.
- b) If the match is tied at eight, a twelve point tie breaker will be played. The first player to win seven points by two wins the tie break, and the match.
- c) Each team must arrive at the scheduled time. If a team is over five minutes late, they will forfeit the match. After two forfeits during the season, the team must forfeit the remainder of the season.
- d) There is no add scoring: instead of scoring 15-30-40, you score 1-2-3, etc. If the score gets to 3-3 tie, a sudden death point results and there is no ad involved.
- e) All results including the score and the winning team must be reported to the Intramural Coordinator at the time of the event. Late reports of scores will not be accepted.
