The Library staff will provide information on copyright, and information fair use. The Granville Fire Department and Police Department will be providing information about fire safety and driving safety. The Columbus Coalition Against Family Violence and Denison SHARE Advocates will be there with information on keeping yourself and family safe. Information that you can take with you will be available at many of the tables. Systems will be available to help you sign up for the emergency notification system and to take our Security Fair Quiz (available on my.denison.edu).
