RECESSIONAL

PROGRAM NOTES

Graduates are listed alphabetically under the degree they are receiving, Bachelor of Fine Arts, Bachelor of Science or Bachelor of Arts. In some cases, a student may earn more than one bachelor's degree during his or her undergraduate years. The student's major(s) are listed to the right of his or her name, with a concentration indicated within parentheses. Directly below each name is the student's home town. Senior Honors Project titles appear in italics underneath the home town, along with the name and terminal degree of the faculty supervisor(s).

President's Medalists wear gold medals awarded to them in recognition of their status. Students graduating as members of the Honors Program wear bronze medals. Students designated in this program as graduates of the Honors Program have achieved a 3.4 grade point average by the end of the sophomore year and maintained it through their senior year, have taken at least four Honors seminars during their Denison career and have completed an Honors project. Student members of Mortar Board, a national honor society that recognizes college seniors for their achievements in scholarship, leadership and service, wear gold tassels on their caps.

Music for the program was coordinated by the Denison Department of Music. Today's processional selections are chosen from *The Water Music* (1717) and *Music for the Royal Fireworks* (1749) by George Frideric Handel (1685-1759). *A Fanfare for the Class of 2006* is an original composition by Assistant Professor of Music Ching-chu Hu. Musical selections are being performed by Annie Chou '09, cello; Co-Director of Denison Suzuki Program Jim Van Reeth, Alexandra Wilson '08, Nicky Duncan '09 and Nellie Schrantz '08, violins; Carl McCoy '07 and Carroll Wallace '08, violas; Affiliate Instructor of Music Jed Hudson, trombone; Assistant Professor of Music Nicolas del Grazia, clarinet; Dan King, trumpet. The group is conducted by Associate Professor of Music Andrew Carlson. The Chapel bell ringer is Jesse Adam Koza '07.

Parents or friends taking pictures of graduates receiving diplomas are asked to use the special section designated for this purpose.

Flowers for the Commencement activities were designed by the Village Flower Basket, Granville, Ohio. Interpretive signing is being provided by Melinda Tellings and Brandi Irons of Hallenross & Associates, LLC.

The program concludes when the platform party and faculty have recessed. The audience and graduates are asked to remain seated during the recessional. In the event that Commencement exercises are held in Mitchell Recreation and Athletics Center, the graduates will also recess.

ACADEMIC REGALIA

The academic costume which makes the Commencement procession so colorful is more than 800 years old, dating back to the days when students were “clerks,” (members of the minor clergy) and wore monkish gowns and hoods. In those days of unheated classrooms and garret sleeping quarters, the hoods were used to keep the wearers warm. The “tipper” on the end of the hood could also be used as a convenient pocket. Today, the hood is used only as an ornament.

Both the gown and the hood indicate the degree held by the wearer, or the degree about to be received. The gown for the bachelor's degree has pointed sleeves and no trimming. The master's gown also has pointed sleeves but they are slit at the elbow; it also is untrimmed. The doctor's gown has bell-shaped sleeves adorned with chevrons and is faced down the front with velvet. Graduates of some institutions wear gowns in the color(s) of the university which awarded their degrees.

In the United States, the doctor's hood is bell shaped. The hood is lined with the colors of the university conferring the degree: the border in which it is edged indicates the scholar's field. The colors seen in today's Denison procession and the fields they represent are: Dark Blue — Philosophy; White — Arts, Letters, the Humanities; Golden Yellow — Science; Light Blue — Education; Brown — Fine Arts; Pink — Music; Silver Gray — Oratory (Speech); Scarlet — Theology; Lemon Yellow — Library Science; Sage Green — Physical Education; Drab — Commerce, Accountancy, Business.

HONORARY DEGREE RECIPIENTS

SYLVIA HURTADO, *Doctor of Social Sciences, honoris causa*

SYLVIA HURTADO is a nationally and internationally recognized scholar in the field of higher education. She is professor and director of the Higher Education Research Institute at UCLA in the Graduate School of Education and Information Sciences, a post she has held since 2004.

A prolific writer, she has focused her research on issues of diversity and democratic practices in education. Her research efforts include a U.S. Department of Education-sponsored project on how colleges are preparing students to achieve the cognitive, social and democratic skills to participate in a diverse democracy. She is launching a National Institutes of Health project on the preparation of underrepresented students for biomedical and behavioral science research careers. A previous research project involved assessment, reform and innovation in undergraduate education through the National Center for Postsecondary Improvement.

Her books include: *Defending Diversity: Affirmative Action at the University of Michigan* (2004), *Intergroup Dialogue: Deliberative Democracy in School, College, Community and Workplace* (2001) and *Enacting Diverse Learning Environments: Improving the Campus Climate for Racial/Ethnic Diversity in Higher Education* (1999). Prior to her current position, she served as Director of the Center for the Study of Higher and Postsecondary Education at the University of Michigan from 2000 to 2003. She joined the University of Michigan School of Education as an assistant professor in 1992 and was named associate professor in 1997.

Born in San Antonio, Texas, Hurtado earned an A.B. in Sociology from Princeton University in 1980 and was certified to teach both Spanish and social studies in the State of New Jersey. She continued her education at Harvard University, earning an Ed.M. in Administration, Planning and Social Policy in 1983 and a Ph.D. in Education from the Graduate School of Education at UCLA in 1990.

Black Issues in Higher Education named Hurtado among the top 15 influential faculty who personify scholarship, service and integrity and whose work has had substantial impact on the academy. Her other honors include the Harold R. Johnson Diversity Award, 1998, University of Michigan; the Distinguished Early Career Award, 1995-96, Association for the Study of Higher Education; and the Evan and Helen Geib Pattishall Junior Faculty Research Award, 1994, University of Michigan School of Education.

Hurtado was on the board of the American Association of Higher Education from 1996 to 2000 and currently serves on the Research and Evaluation Advisory Board of the Gates Millennium Scholarship Program. She was president of Association for the Study of Higher Education in 2004-2005. She has served on numerous editorial advisory boards and has been a keynote speaker at lecture series and conferences throughout the United States and in South Africa. Hurtado was a convocation speaker at Denison in February of this year, presenting "Linking Diversity with the Educational and Civic Mission of the Institution."

JOHN BRADFORD TILLSON JR. '66 *Doctor of Humane Letters, honoris causa*

BRAD TILLSON, former president and CEO of Cox Ohio Publishing, has had a distinguished career in journalism and a lifelong dedication to community service in Dayton, Ohio, the city where he has lived since 1971.

A native of Paris, Texas, he graduated from The Loomis School in Windsor, Conn., in 1962 before enrolling at Denison. During his college years, Tillson was an English major and editor of Denison's student newspaper, *The Denisonian*. He earned a bachelor of arts degree on June 13, 1966, and entered the U.S. Navy the following August where he served as a junior communications officer until September 1969, including three tours on aircraft carriers in the Vietnam war zone.

Following military service, he worked as a reporter for the *Charlotte (N.C.) News* covering medicine and city government. In September 1971, he joined the *Dayton Daily News*, reporting on county and city government and special projects before moving to the newspaper's Columbus Bureau where he covered state government and state and national politics. Tillson was named assistant city editor in January 1977 and later was promoted to city editor, assistant managing editor, managing editor and, in September 1984, editor. In June 1988, he became publisher.

Tillson was named president and CEO of Cox Ohio Publishing in January 1996, a position from which he retired in December 2003. During his tenure, he was responsible for four daily newspapers, five weekly newspapers, specialty publications, commercial printing and internet publishing. During that period, the *Dayton Daily News* won numerous awards, including a Pulitzer Prize for national reporting.

Tillson chaired Inventing Flight: Dayton 2003, the city's celebration of the centennial of the Wright brothers' first powered flight. He served as president of the Dayton Art Institute and chaired its capital campaign. He is past chair of the Dayton Development Coalition, Dayton Area Chamber of Commerce and Dayton and Montgomery County Alliance for Education. He is a member of the Advisory Board of the Kiplinger Program in Public Affairs Journalism at Ohio State University. Tillson has received the U.S. Interior Department Conservation Award, Air Force Association Ambassador Award, Ohio Newspaper Association President's Award and Big Brothers Big Sisters Community Service Award. In 1990, he was the recipient of a Denison Alumni Citation.

Tillson lives in Kettering, a suburb of Dayton, and has two children, John and Karen, and three grandchildren.
